Policies Governing Use of Special Collections Materials

The Arizona Health Sciences Library Special Collections is open to researchers by appointment. Reading privileges in this room are granted subject to the following policies. Researchers may be barred from future use of the room for violating these policies.

- All coats, briefcases, backpacks, handbags, notebooks and other personal property not essential to research are to be left in lockers provided outside Special Collections.
- Food, beverages, and smoking are not allowed.
- All materials are to be handled with great care. Materials are not to be leaned upon, written upon, marked, altered, or otherwise mishandled.
- One manuscript box or one folder of photograph files is permitted per table. All documents must remain in folders at all times. Pull only one folder at a time from manuscript boxes.
- Only pencils or computers may be used to transcribe notes.
- Permission to examine materials does not imply permission to publish or quote. It is the
 researcher's responsibility to obtain authorization to publish or quote from the appropriate
 source. Researchers who plan to publish are urged to inquire about any restrictions or fees
 before beginning research. A separate request for permission to publish must be submitted. A
 complimentary copy of the publication using Special Collection manuscript holdings should be
 provided to the Library as soon as the work is published. All appearances of Special Collections
 material must be cited:

[name of collection, box and folder, or other unique identification], courtesy of Arizona Health Sciences Library, Special Collections.

- Special Collections reserves the right to deny access to any material that is fragile, not yet processed, or which is restricted at the wish of the donor.
- Theft or mutilation of materials is a crime that will be prosecuted.
- All photocopying is subject to condition of materials or donor restriction.
- Researchers may be required to use printed copies, microforms, or other facsimile reproductions.
- Personal digital cameras may be used for research purposes only. Researchers must alert staff and complete a personal camera use agreement prior to use.
